Accept a grant agreement from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, State Assistance for Fentanyl Eradication, totaling \$25,250

BACKGROUND:

State funding is available to conduct investigations designed to combat illegal fentanyl activity. This grant provides reimbursement for approved fentanyl-related activities including investigative operations. The Ocala Police department has applied for \$25,250 in funds to provide the Unified Drug Enforcement Drug Enforcement Strike team with overtime to conduct investigative operations.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

Grant funding will enable the Ocala Police department drug agents to work overtime hours to conduct fentanyl eradication operations.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A \$25,250 award will support overtime operations, with no match required. Funds will be held in account number 001-050-827-521-52-14010.
