**AMENDMENT NUMBER 2 TO IPO 2021-13
BETWEEN KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC.
AND THE CITY OF OCALA**

AMENDMENT NUMBER 2 DATED October 13, 2025, to IPO 2021-13 between City of Ocala ("the City") and Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. ("Kimley-Horn or Consultant"), dated February 17, 2022 (the "IPO") concerning Bus Stop Design Services (SUN/210172) (the "Project").

Kimley-Horn has entered into the IPO with the City for the furnishing of professional services, and the parties now desire to amend the IPO.

Therefore, it is mutually agreed that the IPO is amended to include Additional Services to be performed by Kimley-Horn and provisions for additional compensation by the City to Kimley-Horn, all as set forth in Exhibit A hereto. The parties ratify the terms and conditions of the IPO, not consistent with this Amendment, all of which are incorporated by reference.

Project Understanding

Additional Survey and Site Plan work is needed for an additional bus stop location.

Scope of Services

Task 1 – Site Plan and Permitting

- A. Kimley-Horn will prepare civil engineering infrastructure plans for one bus stop at the Florida Department of Health in Ocala, Marion County, Florida. Address: 1801 SE 32nd Ave, Ocala, FL 34471.
- B. Plans will include a plan view that shows the dimensions of the proposed bus shelter footprint, concrete pad, spot grates, and existing improvements.
- C. This Task assumes that the City will select a single vendor-provided bus shelter for use in this Project. Architectural design services are not included in this Agreement.
- D. Kimley-Horn will submit the construction plans to the City of Ocala for review and comment.
- E. Kimley-Horn will provide responses to up to two rounds of comments from City staff regarding the construction plan application.
- F. It is assumed the project will be exempt from water management district permitting. If permitting is required, additional services will be needed.

Task 2 – Survey Services

- A. Kimley-Horn, through a local subconsultant, will provide the following survey services for the Project for one additional bus stop. The surveyor will prepare a Specific Purpose/Topographic Survey. The survey will include:
 - 1) Approximate limits of right-of-way (ROW) based on found monumentation and/or plats of records.
 - 2) Observable utilities – Utility poles, telephone boxes, valve boxes, manholes, etc. If manholes are found, including inverts.
 - 3) Topographic data will be collected at 100-foot cross sections, including data collected at ROW, top of bank, toe of slope, flow line of swales, edge of pavement, and center of road, and center of ROW.
 - 4) Horizontal & Vertical data will meet or exceed Standards of Practice as set forth by the Florida Board of Professional Surveyors and Mappers in Chapter 5J-17.050-052, Florida Administrative Code, pursuant to Section 472.027, Florida Statutes.
 - 5) Location of any improvements that will interfere with the design or construction, including pipelines, inverts, and all trees 10" or larger.
 - 6) Set two benchmarks at each site
 - 7) State Plane Coordinates



- 8) Location of all surface evidence of utilities along the subject parcel and contiguous ROW, as well as utility marks as delineated by requesting through Sunshine State One Call. Other than obtaining inverts of accessible manholes, drop inlets, etc., underground location of utilities will be shown as delineated by others. Power poles will be located with overhead wires.
- 9) Vertical datum will be on NAVD 1988
- 10) Contours will be shown on a 1' for minor, and 5' for major

Additional Services If Required

Services requested that are not specifically included will be provided under a new and separate IPO agreement or can be performed on an hourly basis upon written authorization.

Schedule

Kimley-Horn will provide the above Scope of Services as expeditiously as practicable to meet a mutually agreeable schedule.

Fee and Billing

Kimley-Horn will complete the above scope of services for the lump sum fee of \$12,586.48; details are shown in the attached Table A.
