1) Marion County Local Mitigation Strategy & Five-Year Plan Udpate

- i. Marion County has adopted a Local Mitigation Strategy in accordance with the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000.
- ii. Chapter 44 CFR Sections 201 & 206 provide that local jurisdiction(s) must review and revise the local mitigation plan to reflect changes in development, progress in local mitigation efforts, and changes in priorities, and update the local mitigation plan a minimum of every five (5) years in order to continue to be eligible for Federal hazard mitigation funds under the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA").
- iii. The LMS Five-Year Plan was updated in 2021. The LMS Plan Five-Year Update was approved by the Marion County Board of County Commissioners on May 4, 2021 by Resolution No. 21-R-214. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) granted formal approval of the document on July 28, 2021. It will expire on May 19, 2026. As an approved participating jurisdiction, the County is an eligible applicant for the following mitigation programs administered by FEMA: Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC), and Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA).
- iv. The LMS is coordinated by the Marion County Growth Services Department, 2710 E. Silver Springs Blvd., Ocala, FL 34470. Staff contact is Kenneth Odom, Transportation Planner.
- v. In accordance with the LMS by-laws, the strategy is guided by a local working group led by a Steering Committee containing representatives from Marion County, incorporated municipalities, key businesses, interest groups and citizens.

2) LMS Project List – "Mitigation Initiatives"

- The 2024 announcements notice for new project submittal were transmitted on February 28, 2023: Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Projects. No new projects were ranked or added to the list during this calendar year.
- ii. One project reached the 5-year expiration window:
 - i. City of Ocala Emergency Generators 2019-01

3) Election of Officers

i. On April 17, 2024, the LMS Steering Committee elected Erin Miller, Sheriff's Office Emergency Management Deputy Director as Chairman and Sean Lanier, Director, Office of City Engineer, City of Ocala as Vice Chairman. The January LMS Committee meeting has been cancelled because no actionable items needed to be voted on and no discussion items were of critical nature that could not be taken up at the next meeting. That meeting will be held in April 2025 where new officer elections will take place.


