# OCALA'S RELEVANT STRATEGIC GOALS: Operational Excellence

### **BACKGROUND:**

On July 1, 2014 the City of Ocala approved an update to the original 2002 State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation agreement. The Public Works Department/Traffic Division maintains all of the traffic signals within the City of Ocala, including those on state roads.

### FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

This revision to the agreement clarifies maintenance of mast arm structures, equipment replacement, maintenance intervals, future reimbursement amounts and annual maintenance reporting requirements to FDOT. The Public Works Department/Traffic Division has reviewed the terms of the agreement and finds it is beneficial to the City of Ocala.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The City of Ocala will receive compensation of \$218,880.00 during the FDOT FY16 period.
