BACKGROUND:

The City manages a fleet of approximately 1,700 vehicles consisting of cars, light trucks, heavy-duty trucks, and tractors. Annually, over 1,400 tires require repair or replacement.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

On March 28, 2023, the City issued an Invitation to Bid (ITB) FLT/230356 for the provision of tire repair and related services on an as-needed basis. The vendor will provide mounting, balancing, and emergency tire roadside service for all City vehicles 24 hours per day, seven days per week.

The City received two bids which were evaluated based on sample quantities used by the City. The lowest qualified and responsible bidder was Advanced Tire Service, LLC.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The estimated annual expenditure is \$225,000. Funding for tire service and repairs is available in the Fleet Repair and Maintenance account 001-025-523-519-51-46010.

PROCUREMENT REVIEW:

These goods and services were procured in compliance with the City's procurement policy.
