

THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PHYSICAL ACCESS SECURITY SYSTEM AND SERVICE PLAN

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PHYSICAL ACCESS SECURITY SYSTEM AND SERVICE PLAN ("Third Amendment") is entered into by and between the **CITY OF OCALA**, a Florida municipal corporation ("City") and **WALTER CONRAD HOLDINGS**, **INC. D/B/A SONITROL OF NORTH CENTRAL FLORIDA** a for-profit corporation duly organized and authorized to do business in the state of Florida (EIN: 20-1355543) ("Vendor").

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2017, City and Vendor entered into an Agreement for Physical Access Security System and Service Plan (the "Original Agreement"), City of Ocala Contract No.: ELE/240914; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2018, City and Vendor entered into a First Amendment to Agreement for Physical Access Security System and Service Plan (the "First Amendment"), to upgrade the existing systems and to add additional service locations; and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2024, City and Vendor entered into a Second Amendment to Agreement for Physical Access Security System and Service Plan (the "Second Amendment"), to extend the Original Agreement, as amended, for a one-year renewal period available under the Original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, City and Vendor now desire to renew the Original Agreement for a (1) one-year renewal period.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals, the following mutual covenants and conditions, and other good and valuable consideration, City and Vendor agree as follows:

- 1. **RECITALS**. City and Vendor hereby represent, warrant, and agree that the Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. **INCORPORATION OF ORIGINAL AGREEMENT.** The Original Agreement, as amended, between City and Vendor is hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth herein in its entirety and remains in full force and effect, except, for those terms and conditions expressly amended by this Second Amendment.
- 3. **RENEWAL TERM.** The Original Agreement, as amended, is hereby renewed for an additional (1) one-year term beginning on <u>OCTOBER 1, 2025</u>, and terminating <u>SEPTEMBER 30, 2026</u>, in accordance with the document attached as **Exhibit C Maintenance Support Plan**.
- 4. **COMPENSATION.** City shall pay Vendor a price not to exceed **FORTY THOUSAND EIGHTY-ONE AND 74/100 DOLLARS (\$40,081.74)** (the "Contract Sum") over the Renewal Term as full and complete compensation for the timely and satisfactory provision of services.
- 6. NOTICES. All notices, certifications or communications required by this Third Amendment shall be given in writing and shall be deemed delivered when personally served, or when received if by facsimile transmission with a confirming copy mailed by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested. Notices can be concurrently delivered by e-mail. All notices shall be addressed to the respective parties as follows:

- 9. **LEGAL AUTHORITY**. Each person signing this Third Amendment on behalf of either party individually warrants that he or she has full legal power to execute this Third Amendment on behalf of the party for whom he or she is signing, and to bind and obligate such party with respect to all provisions contained in this Third Amendment.

ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE

From time to time, City of Ocala - Procurement & Contracting (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Getting paper copies
