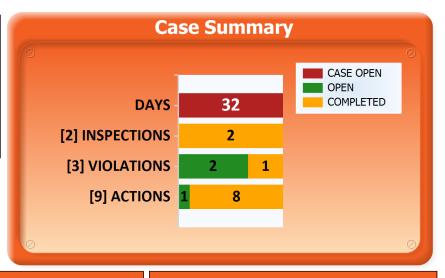

The pictures of the residence show the damage to the ceiling in several rooms and the extent of the flooring damage from the water and the falling insulation. The residence had an odor from urine and feces that was in the back room. The rear yard had trash and debris along with overgrowth. There was also a derelict vehicle in the driveway with expired tags (2023). The house was red-tagged and deemed a dangerous structure by building inspector McClellan.

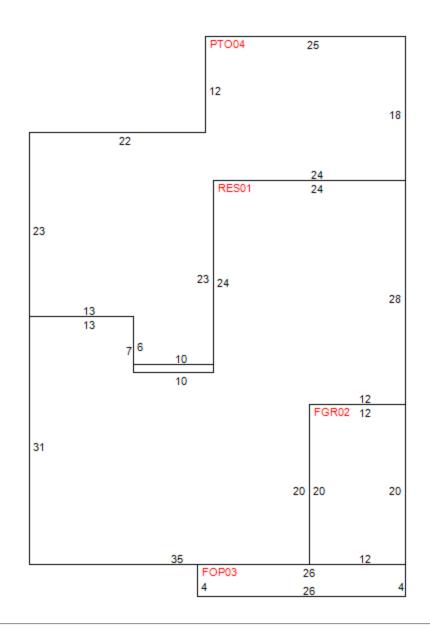

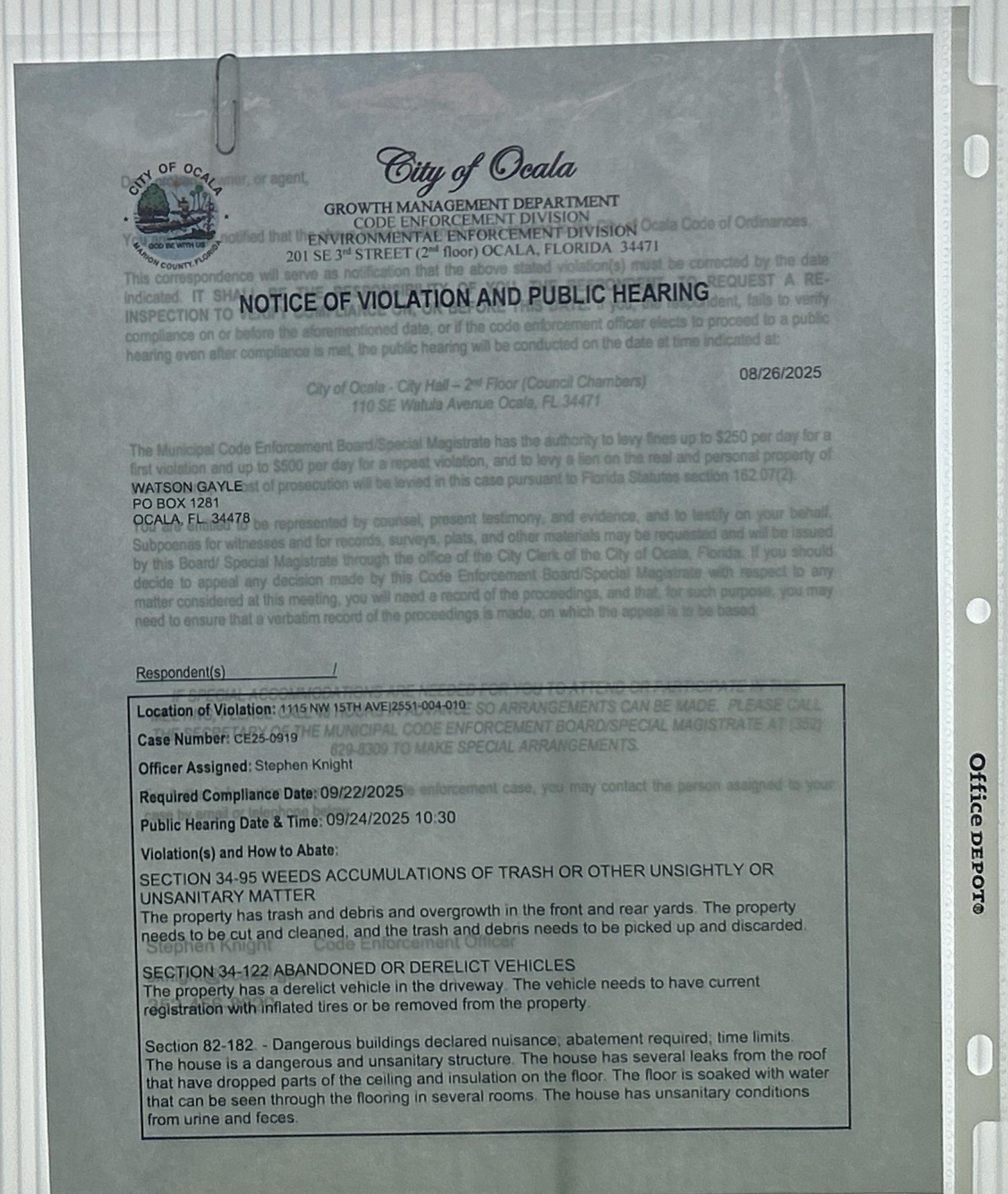

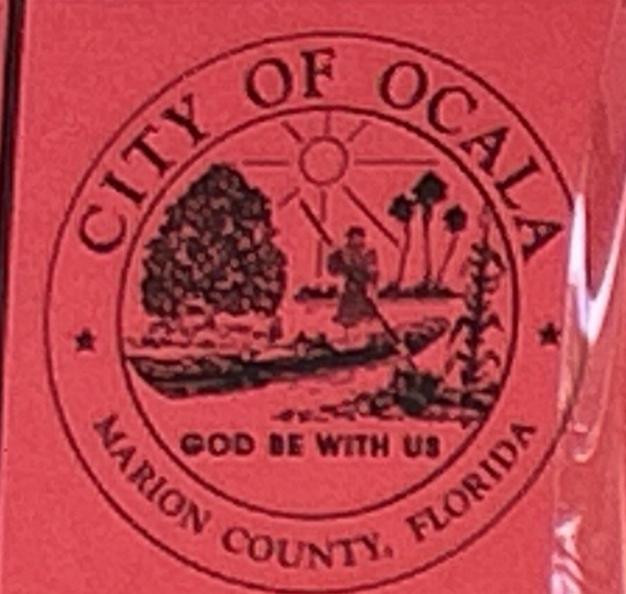
