

FIRST AMENDMENT TO END USER AGREEMENT - HGAC HP08-21

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO END USER AGREEMENT - HP08-21("First Amendment") is entered into by and between CITY OF OCALA, a Florida municipal corporation ("City"), and WITT O'BRIEN'S, LLC, a limited liability company duly organized in the state of Delaware and authorized to do business in the state of Florida (EIN: 27-2783923) ("Consultant").

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2021, the Houston Galveston Area Council (HGAC) and Consultant entered into HGAC Agreement HP08-21 (the "HGAC Agreement") for Consultant to provide All Hazards Preparedness, Planning, Consulting, Response, and Recovery Services; and

WHEREAS, on January 1, 2022, City and Consultant entered into an End User Agreement for All Hazards Preparedness, Planning, Consulting, Response, and Recovery Services (the "Original Agreement"), City of Ocala Contract No.: FIN/190687; and

WHEREAS, on July 3, 2023, the Houston Galveston Area Council and Consultant extended the term of the HGAC Agreement until July 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant now desire to extend the Original Agreement, as written, for a one-year renewal period.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of each of the foregoing recitals and the following mutual covenants, conditions and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby mutually acknowledged, City and Consultant agree as follows:

- 1. **RECITALS.** City and Consultant hereby represent and warrant that the Recitals set forth above are true and correct.
- 2. INCORPORATION OF ORIGINAL AGREEMENT. The Original Agreement between City and Consultant is hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth herein in its entirety and remains in full force and effect, except for those terms and conditions expressly amended by this First Amendment.
- 3. **RENEWAL TERM**. The Original Agreement is hereby renewed for an additional one-year term beginning AUGUST 1, 2023 and terminating JULY 31, 2024, in accordance with Amendment No. 1 to Contract No. HP08-21, attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 4. **AMOUNTS DUE TO THE CITY**. Consultant must be current and remain current in all obligations due to the City during the performance of services under this Agreement. Payments to Consultant may be offset by any delinquent amounts due to the City or fees and/or charges owed to the City.
- 5. **NOTICES**. All notices, certifications or communications required by this First Amendment shall be given in writing and shall be deemed delivered when personally served, or when received if by facsimile transmission with a confirming copy mailed by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested. Notices can be concurrently delivered by email. All notices shall be addressed to the respective parties as follows:

ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE

From time to time, City of Ocala - Procurement & Contracting (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Described below are the terms and conditions for providing to you such notices and disclosures electronically through the DocuSign system. Please read the information below carefully and thoroughly, and if you can access this information electronically to your satisfaction and agree to this Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure (ERSD), please confirm your agreement by selecting the check-box next to 'I agree to use electronic records and signatures' before clicking 'CONTINUE' within the DocuSign system.

Getting paper copies

At any time, you may request from us a paper copy of any record provided or made available electronically to you by us. You will have the ability to download and print documents we send to you through the DocuSign system during and immediately after the signing session and, if you elect to create a DocuSign account, you may access the documents for a limited period of time (usually 30 days) after such documents are first sent to you. After such time, if you wish for us to send you paper copies of any such documents from our office to you, you will be charged a \$0.00 per-page fee. To withdraw your consent with City of Ocala - Procurement & Contracting

To inform us that you no longer wish to receive future notices and disclosures in electronic format you may:

i. decline to sign a document from within your signing session, and on the subsequent page, select the check-box indicating you wish to withdraw your consent, or you may;

ii. send us an email to contracts@ocalafl.org and in the body of such request you must state your email, full name, mailing address, and telephone number. We do not need any other information from you to withdraw consent.. The consequences of your withdrawing consent for online documents will be that transactions may take a longer time to process..
