This procurement exception is APPROVED as follows: Procurement Policy PRO-060 requires goods with an aggregate contract value of \$50,001 or more to be procured through a formal sealed competitive process formally hosted by the Procurement and Contracting Department unless waived by the Procurement and Contracting Officer in response to the using department's written exception request. Here, the services being procured required the analysis of highly technical or functional specifications which warrant basing a contract award on factors other than price alone. The Information Technology Department conducted market research which included comprehensive demonstration sessions with three qualified vendors: (1) Confience (\$58,150); (2) Clinisys (\$92,800); and (3) LabWorks (\$98,915). Confience was found to afford the City best value not only due to it being the lowest priced solution, but due to its increased functionality and quality. LIMS Replacement Policy Exception Request:

A Laboratory Information Management System (LIMS) is a software solution designed to manage and streamline the operations of a laboratory. It provides functionalities for sample tracking, data management, and quality control to ensure accurate and efficient analysis of water samples. LIMS automates workflow processes, reduces errors, and facilitates regulatory compliance by maintaining comprehensive records and generating necessary reports. It enhances the laboratory's ability to monitor water quality and effectively detect contaminants or pollutants. By integrating various instruments and data sources, LIMS ensures reliable and consistent results for water testing labs.

LabLite LLC, the current LIMS platform used by the Water Resources Department since 2012, is facing significant operational challenges. Frequent server restarts are needed, causing delays. The system retains qualifier codes indefinitely, cluttering reports. It lacks critical features like direct Excel uploads, quality control tracking, chemical inventory management, personnel management with alerts, and automatic flagging of out-of-control data. These limitations underscore the urgent need for a software replacement to enhance efficiency and functionality.

The Water Resources and Information Technology departments conducted market research to compare vendor offerings and platform capabilities and have chosen Accelerated Technology Laboratories LLC's Confience as the LIMS platform. Confience's projected cost is the lowest among all proposals and falls within the annual budget limit of \$60,000. Additionally, Confidence offers key features that align with operational needs, such as user-friendly templates for routine sampling processes and the direct upload of Excel files into LIMS. Their robust tools for tracking quality assurance and quality control metrics enable the analysis of trends over time, ensuring high standards and quick issue resolution. Moreover, generating detailed charts for the Minimum Detection Limit (MDL) and Practical Quantitation Limit (PQL) is crucial for testing processes. Confience also provides efficient tracking systems for Documents of Compliance, ensuring easy access and organization of necessary documents. Overall, Confience meets budgetary requirements and offers features that will significantly enhance laboratory operations for the Water Resources
