

## SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR SINGLE-STREAM CURBSIDE RECYCLING

THIS SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR SINGLE-STREAM CURBSIDE RECYCLING ("Seventh Amendment") is entered into by and between **CITY OF OCALA**, a Florida municipal corporation ("City"), and **WASTE PRO OF FLORIDA**, **INC.**, a for-profit corporation duly organized and authorized to do business in the state of Florida (EIN# 59-3701785) ("Vendor").

**WHEREAS**, on May 15, 2018, City and Vendor entered into an Agreement for Single-Stream Curbside Recycling for a term of five (5) years from October 1, 2018, through September 30, 2023, City of Ocala Contract Number: PWD/18-014 (the "Original Agreement"); and

**WHEREAS**, on December 30, 2019, City and Vendor entered into a First Amendment (the "First Amendment") of Agreement for Single-Stream Curbside Recycling, modifying the compensation in accordance with the escalation provisions in the Original Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 10, 2021, City and Vendor entered into a Second Amendment (the "Second Amendment") of Agreement for Single-Stream Curbside Recycling, to amend the compensation pursuant to the escalation provisions in the Original Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 12, 2021, City and Vendor entered into a Third Amendment (the "Third Amendment") of Agreement for Single-Stream Curbside Recycling, to amend the compensation pursuant to the escalation provisions in the Original Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 31, 2023, City and Vendor entered into a Fourth Amendment (the "Fourth Amendment") of Agreement for Single-Stream Curbside Recycling, to further amend the compensation per Section 3, Escalation of the Original Agreement utilizing the CPI-U Index; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 10, 2023, City and Vendor entered into a Fifth Amendment (the "Fifth Amendment") of Agreement for Single-Stream Curbside Recycling, extending the Original Agreement for the available five-year renewal period and further amending the compensation and contamination provisions.

**WHEREAS**, on October 30, 2024, City and Vendor entered into a Sixth Amendment (the "Sixth Amendment") of Agreement for Single-Stream Curbside Recycling, amending the compensation terms in the Original Agreement.

**WHEREAS**, Vendor has requested an increase to the contract compensation amount pursuant to the CPI-U Index.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of each of the foregoing recitals and the following mutual covenants, conditions and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby mutually acknowledged, City and Vendor agree as follows:

- 1. **RECITALS.** City and Vendor hereby represent and warrant that the Recitals set forth above are true and correct.
- INCORPORATION OF ORIGINAL AGREEMENT. The Original Agreement between City and Vendor, as amended, is hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth herein in its entirety and remains in full force and effect, except for those terms and conditions expressly amended by this Seventh Amendment.
- 3. **COMPENSATION.** Effective **OCTOBER 1, 2025**, the City shall pay the Vendor for the performance of the work, and in accordance with the contract documents a total of **\$427.13 per ton (FOUR**)



<u>HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN AND 13/100 DOLLARS/TON</u>) which represents a 5% increase based on the most recent **twelve (12) month** period of the CPI-U Index.

4. **NOTICES**. All notices, certifications or communications required by this Seventh Amendment shall be given in writing and shall be deemed delivered when personally served, or when received if by facsimile transmission with a confirming copy mailed by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested. Notices can be concurrently delivered by e-mail. All notices shall be addressed to the respective parties as follows:



Further, a duplicate or copy of the Seventh Amendment that contains a duplicated or non-original signature will be treated the same as an original, signed copy of this original Seventh Amendment for all purposes.
- 7. **LEGAL AUTHORITY**. Each person signing this Seventh Amendment on behalf of either party individually warrants that he or she has full legal power to execute this Seventh Amendment on behalf of the party for whom he or she is signing, and to bind and obligate such party with respect to all provisions contained in this Seventh Amendment.
