Approve expenditures for utility services provided by Duke Energy, Inc. for Fiscal Year 2023-24 with an estimated annual expenditure of \$140,000

BACKGROUND:

The City of Ocala Water Resources Department utilizes Duke Energy, Inc. (Duke) for electric services at various lift stations, the Perry Sprayfield in Belleview, and automated meter reading (AMR) locations throughout the City.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

Fiscal Year 2021-2022 expenditures for electrical services totaled \$75,253.88. Expenditures for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 totaled \$95,500.34 due to increasing utility costs. Staff projects that expenditures for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 will total \$140,000. Expenditures will be tracked under Contract No.: WRS/240111.

Staff recommends approval.
