Attachment A SLSA Addendum

This SLSA ADDENDUM (the "<u>SLSA Addendum"</u>) is entered into by and between **Cellcontrol**, **Inc. dba TRUCE Software** ("<u>TRUCE</u>") and the licensee named below ("<u>Customer</u>"), and is effective as of the date on which the last of the two parties has signed below.

All capitalized terms used in this SLSA Addendum and not specifically defined herein shall have the meaning set forth in TRUCE's standard Software License and Services Agreement (the "SLSA") which is available here.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary expressed or implied in the SLSA, TRUCE and Customer agree to amend the Standard Terms of the SLSA as follows:

1. <u>Term.</u> Section 2.b. of the Standard Terms is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following inserted in its place:

"Term of Subscription Order(s). The License granted to the Customer under each Subscription Order will be effective for a period (the "Term") commencing on the Subscription Order Start Date and continuing until the expiration of the "Term" set forth in that Subscription Order."

2. <u>Indemnification</u>. Section 15.a. of the Standard Terms is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following inserted in its place:

"Customer will indemnify, defend and hold harmless TRUCE and its affiliates, and their respective officers, directors, shareholders, employees, successors and assigns, from and against all losses, claims, judgments, liabilities, damages, fines, penalties, assessments, actions or causes of action (including reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs) (collectively, "Losses") to the extent arising out of any third party claim relating to or based upon (i) any negligence or willful misconduct of Customer, its Users, Administrators, or other employees, contractors, personnel or agents, or (ii) any death, personal injury or property damage suffered by any of Customer's employees, contractors, agents or other personnel (including claims asserted under workers' compensation laws or similar laws). Notwithstanding the foregoing or anything to the contrary in this Agreement, Customer will have no obligation to indemnify TRUCE for any Losses that are (x) subject to TRUCE's indemnification obligations under Section 15.b. below."

- 3. <u>Confidentiality.</u> The definition of "Confidential Information" in Section 1.d. of the Standard Terms is hereby amended to provide that pricing and fees relating to the TRUCE System shall not be deemed to constitute "Confidential Information." Furthermore, the second sentence in Section 16 of the Standard Terms is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- 4. <u>Dispute Resolution</u>. Section 21.b. of the Standard Terms (Agreement to Arbitrate) is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- 5. <u>Governing Law; Jurisdiction; Venue.</u> Section 22 of the Standard Terms is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following inserted in its place:

"Governing Law: Jurisdiction: Venue: This Agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance withthe laws of the State of Florida. Each party hereby consents to the personal jurisdiction of the State of Florida, acknowledges that venue is proper in the state court in Marion County, Florida or federal court in the Middle District of Florida, Ocala Division, agrees that any action arising out of or related to this Agreement must be brought exclusively in a state or federal court in the State of Florida, and waives any objection it

has or may have in the future with respect to any of the foregoing. The parties expressly agree that this Agreement will not be governed by the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods, the application of which is expressly excluded."

- 6. Marketing Rights. Section 31 of the Standard Terms is hereby deleted in its entirety.
- Ratification and Confirmation of Agreement. Except as expressly modified herein, the Agreement and all of the terms and conditions set forth therein are hereby ratified and confirmed in all respects.
- 8. <u>Counterparts; Electronic Signature.</u> This SLSA Addendum may be executed in two (2) or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Counterparts may be delivered via facsimile, electronic mail (including pdf or any electronic signature complying with the U.S. federal ESIGN Act of 2000, e.g., www.docusign.com) or other transmission method and any counterpart so delivered shall be deemed to have been duly and validly delivered and be valid and effective for all purposes.
