As a political subdivision of the state of Florida and public transit agency, the City of Ocala's SunTran program is authorized to make purchases subject to the terms and conditions of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Public Transit Office's Transit Research Inspection Procurement Services ("TRIPS") Contract No. TRIPS-21-APTS for intelligent transportation systems/technology solutions for public transit agencies. On March 15, 2022, FDOT issued its Intent to Award Contract No. 21-APTS to Avail Technologies for the delivery of these systems, which includes a provision which allows the contractor (Avail Technologies) to submit to eligible users a firm fixed price for each of the first full five years of ongoing support and maintenance services. The quote provided does not expressly mention the TRIPS contract. To the extent that FTA funds will be utilized to pay for these services, please ensure that the agreement also incorporates the required federalized terms. PLEASE HAVE THE VENDOR UPDATE TO REFLECT THIS INFORMATION. You may proceed with your purchase. PLEASE ESTABLISH A MUNIS CONTRACT NUMBER WITH AN EXPIRATION DATE WHICH MATCHES THE CONTRACT. SunTran has had a successful partnership with Avail Technologies and it is in our best interest to continue the agreement for an additional three years.

The Avail Technologies contract has been competitively sourced via the TRIPS Contract TRIPS-21-APTS and is fully compliant with the Federal procurement guidelines.
