Marion County Local Mitigation Strategy

January 5, 2022

1) Marion County Local Mitigation Strategy & Five-Year Plan Update

- a. Marion County has adopted a Local Mitigation Strategy in accordance with the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000.
- b. Chapter 44 CFR Sections 201 & 206 provide that local jurisdiction(s) must review and revise the local mitigation plan to reflect changes in development, progress in local mitigation efforts, and changes in priorities, and update the local mitigation plan a minimum of every five (5) years in order to continue to be eligible for Federal hazard mitigation funds under the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA").
- c. The LMS Five-Year Plan was updated in 2021. The LMS Plan Five-Year Update was approved by the Marion County Board of County Commissioners on May 4, 2021 by Resolution No. 21-R-214. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) granted formal approval of the document on July 28, 2021. It will expire on May 19, 2026. As an approved participating jurisdiction, the County is an eligible applicant for the following mitigation programs administered by FEMA: Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC), and Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA).
- d. The LMS is coordinated by the Marion County Growth Services Department, 2710 E. Silver Springs Blvd., Ocala, FL 34470. Staff contact is Kenneth Odom, Transportation Planner.
- e. In accordance with the LMS by-laws, the strategy is guided by a local working group led by a Steering Committee containing representatives from Marion County, incorporated municipalities, key businesses, interest groups and citizens.

2) LMS Project List – “Mitigation Initiatives”

- a. The 2021 announcements notice for new project submittal were transmitted on May 19, 2021: Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Projects and Flood Mitigation Assistance Grant Program NOFP. The following new projects were ranked and added to the list:
 - i. *Marion County Fire Services: Headquarters Back-Up Generator*
 - ii. *City of Belleview: Water Facility Storm Shutters*
 - iii. *City of Belleview: Lift Station Emergency Generators*
 - iv. *City of Ocala: DR 222 Flood Relief*
- b. No projects reached the 5-year expiration window so there were no deletions from the Priority List.

3) Election of Officers

- a. On February 11, 2021, the LMS Steering Committee elected Erin Miller, Sheriff’s Office Emergency Management Deputy Director as Chairman and Sean Lanier, Director, Office of City Engineer, City of Ocala as Vice Chairman. The LMS Steering Committee has opted to adopt a four-meeting per year schedule instead of a two-meeting per year schedule. The next scheduled meeting will be held in January 2022 where new officer elections will take place.

4) LMS Document Revisions – 2021

- a. Hazard Assessment – Updated Hazard Assessment analysis was completed as part of the LMS Five-Year Plan update.
- b. Critical Facilities – Updated Critical Facility designations were completed with the Five-Year Plan update.
- c. Repetitive Loss – Updated Repetitive Loss analysis was completed with the Five-Year Plan update.
- d. Maps – Updates to all map were completed with the LMS Five-year Plan Update.

5) By-Laws Update/Committee Member Update

- a. No By-Laws Update
- b. Two new representatives were nominated and approved to serve as members of the LMS. Both were replacements for current positions on the LMS Committee. Mr. Brady Nettina replaced Mr. Terrance Smith for representation of Marion County Public Schools (11/18/21) and Ms. Jeannie Rickman replaced Ms. Beth Nelson as a Citizen Representative (10/21/21).

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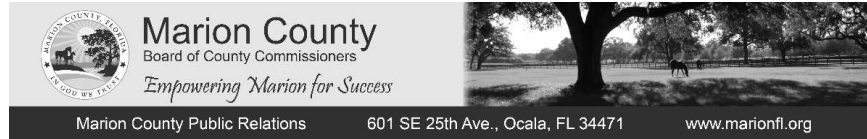

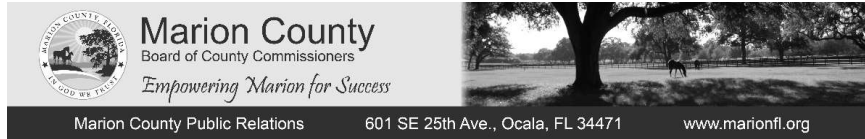
