THIS CAUSE, came for public hearing before the Municipal Code Enforcement Board on April 10th, 2025, after due notice to the Respondent(s), and the Municipal Code Enforcement Board having heard testimony under oath, received evidence, considered stipulations, and heard argument, thereupon issues its Final Administrative Order, Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law, and Notice of Hearing on Compliance, and Imposition of Fines as follows:

- I. FINDINGS OF FACT:
  - A. The Respondent(s), HOLMES, WILLIAM WINDELL EST, HOLMES, SARA LEE EST ET AL, RICHARDSON, DAN III, RICHARDON, TERROL L, owner(s) in charge of the property described as: 2220-005-010 / 1900 BLK NW 11<sup>TH</sup> ST, Ocala, Florida recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida.
  - B. That on and between March 11th, 2025, and April 9th, 2025, the property, as described above, was in violation of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, SECTION 34-95 WEEDS ACCUMULATIONS OF TRASH OR OTHER UNSIGHTLY OR UNSANITARY MATTER.

### II. CONCLUSION OF LAW:

A. The Respondent(s), HOLMES, WILLIAM WINDELL EST, HOLMES, SARA LEE EST ET AL, RICHARDSON, DAN III, RICHARDON, TERROL L, by reason of the foregoing are in violation of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, SECTION 34-95 WEEDS ACCUMULATIONS OF TRASH OR OTHER UNSIGHTLY OR UNSANITARY MATTER, in that the Respondent(s) have failed to remedy the violation(s) and is subject to the provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, Florida, Sections 2-426 and 2-443.

#### III. ORDER:

If the Respondent(s) fail to comply by 7:00am on Friday, May 2nd, 2025, there shall be an additional fine of \$250 per day that shall run concurrent to the fines provided in subsection (a) until this violation has been abated. Additionally, the City shall enter upon the property and take whatever steps are necessary to bring the violations into compliance, to include cutting and cleaning the property grounds, fully and properly removing any weeds, undergrowth, tree debris, and unsightly or unsanitary items.

(c) Upon abatement of any violations of section 34-95 by the City, a \$100.00 service fee shall be applied pursuant to section 34-92(c)(2) of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances.

2.) Pay the cost of prosecution of \$190.11 by May 1st, 2025.

- **B.** This Order may be recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida, and shall constitute a lien against the above described property, and upon any other real, or personal property, owned by the Respondent(s), pursuant to Sections 162.08 and 162.09, Florida State Statutes, and Section 2-426 and 2-443, Code of Ordinances City of Ocala, Florida.


