Gee to get first load is \$18,800. It will take two weeks for driver to get material to Salt Lake City.

Next two loads are: DMV is \$7725+fsc of 49% plus \$200/hr wait time while onsite.

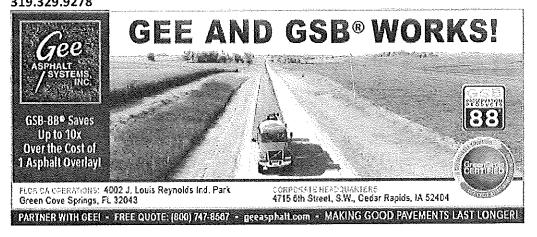
