This notice is to advise you that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Five Grant Review Team has completed the grant application review and ranking process for FY 2025/2026 Public Transit Service Development Program. The Team found SunTran's request eligible for assistance. Please note, final approval of SunTran's grant award will be determined by FDOT Central Office upon further processing. Below is an overview of SunTran's proposed Public Transit Service Development Program project and the anticipated amounts that will be awarded:

Project Summary:

The project will support an innovative fixed-route downtown circulator service's initial marketing efforts and operating expenses. The need for a Downtown Circulator Service was identified during the public engagement for the City's 2035 Vision Plan and Midtown Master Plan and again as part of the FY2018-FY2027 Transit Development Plan (TDP) Major Update. This proposed service is designed to traverse the downtown core, improve mobility for residents and visitors, and increase the exposure of downtown businesses. It also seeks to enhance connections between existing core routes, namely the Orange, Blue, Green, and Purple Routes and connections to the downtown transfer station. The primary activity centers along the proposed route include:

- 1. Downtown Square
- 2. Tourist Development Council
- 3. Marion County Courthouse
- 4. Post Office
- 5. Advent Health Ocala Hospital
- 6. Ocala Regional Medical Center
- 7. Downtown Market & Chamber & Economic Partnership
- 8. City Hall/Citizen's Circle
- 9. Tuscawilla Park
- 10. Reilly Arts Center

11. Downtown Transfer Station
