

Ocala Ground storage Water Tank Mural Summary Agreement

Parties Involved:

Fine Arts for Ocala (FAFO), City of Ocala, Ocala Main Street, Florida Wildlife Corridor

Project:

Ocala Water Tank Mural

Purpose:

To support the creation of a new mural for the downtown Ground Storage Tank located at the intersection of SE Third Ave. and SE Fifth St. in Ocala, Florida. This mural project aims to enhance the aesthetic appeal of the area and promote local flora and fauna.

Support from FAFO:

FAFO agrees to support the Ocala Water Tank Mural project with financial assistance of up to \$15,000. This contribution will be used as part of the funding necessary for the mural's development and execution.

Collaboration:

FAFO will collaborate with the City of Ocala, Ocala Main Street and Florida Wildlife Corridor to facilitate the project's successful completion. The City of Ocala will coordinate agreements with the other two organizations (Ocala Main Street and Florida Wildlife Corridor) and will provide a budget breakdown and timeline for the project.

Terms:

- The specific use of the funds provided by FAFO will be outlined in the project's budget, to be coordinated with the City of Ocala.
- FAFO will have the opportunity to be represented in the project through acknowledgment in related promotional materials and at the mural unveiling event.
- FAFO will assist with marketing and promotion of the project, as well as fundraising if applicable
