STAFF RECOMMENDATION (Motion Ready): Approve Agenda Item (ID # 7010) Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement with the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for reimbursement to the City of \$122,760

OCALA'S RELEVANT STRATEGIC GOALS: Operational Excellence, Quality of Place

BACKGROUND:

On June 11, 2002 the City of Ocala and FDOT entered into a Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement. The Public Works Department, Traffic Division, maintains all of the traffic signals in the City of Ocala. Including those belonging to the county and the state.

The current agreement expires on July 1, 2014. FDOT is requesting the City execute the attached agreement with FDOT to compensate the City for FDOT's share of the signal maintenance costs for 72 signals in the amount of \$122,760 annually.

FINDINGS:

The attached Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement with the State of Florida Department of Transportation has been revised from the previous agreement to include equipment that has been added to the signalized intersection inventory since the execution of the agreement on June 11, 2002. The agreement also includes an increase in compensation for the City compared to the previous agreement to an annual amount of \$122,760.

CONCLUSIONS:

The Traffic Division has reviewed the terms of the attached Agreement. The Division believes it is beneficial to the City and an improvement upon the prior agreement.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City of Ocala will receive compensation of \$122,760 during the FDOT FY14 period.

LEGAL REVIEW:

The agreement has been reviewed and approved for form and legality by the City Attorney, Patrick G. Gilligan.

ALTERNATIVE:

Do not approve the agreement and have the City pay for maintenance of the traffic signals.
