**PERMIT FOR TEMPORARY STREET, ALLEY, SIDEWALK, PARADE, OR
PROCESSION CLOSURE**

Under the authority of the City of Ocala's Code of Ordinance 4096, Subsection 58-5 (C), adopted October 23rd, 2001, and in consideration of the conditions and provisions hereinafter contained, permit is hereby granted to Douglas Law Firm
Permittee to close North Magnolia Avenue at the corner of NW 2nd Street

1. Hold the City of Ocala harmless for all claims, suits, or actions of any kind whatsoever; arising out of or resulting from the closures, the issuance of the permit, or the operations or activities of the permittee.
2. During the period of the permit and closure, general liability insurance naming the City as an additional insured with coverage for bodily injury and property damage with combined single limits of not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence shall be provided and maintained. (Permittee to furnish certificate of insurance certifying that the City of Ocala is insured in accordance with the above requirements either endorsement or by an owner's protective policy.)
3. To suitably and effectively place, construct, or install properly lighted barricades approved by the City Engineer at each end and at all times during the period of the closure.
4. To repair any and all damages caused to the street and to remove all trash, debris and foreign matter caused by or derived from the activity.
5. To accept all of the terms and conditions of the permit by proper execution of each permit.
6. To pay to the City of Ocala all salary costs, incurred by the City for personnel explicitly assigned to said activity. The estimated cost shall be paid in advance upon completion of the activity; the actual cost shall be determined and any underpayment shall be paid by the permittee within thirty (30) days after being invoiced by the City.

This permit is issued for 1 day(s) beginning October 10, 2024 at 3:30pm and ending October 10, 2024 at 8:30pm, and may be cancelled prior to expiration by written notice from the City.
