Notes: Council Member Mansfield asked how much money the City will save after installation of the meters. City Engineer & Director of Water Resources Sean Lanier responded the City will save time reading the meter manuals. Currently, the City expenses \$250,000 annually, for temporary help reading the meters. The request before Council is the labor fees to install the new system. The City will be receiving an unknown prorated settlement amount for the existing failed system.

Approve agreement with Utility Metering Solutions, LLC. for the installation and integration of a fixed network metering system for the Water Resources Department in the estimated amount of \$732,595

BACKGROUND:

This project consists of the installation and integration of a fixed network metering system for the Water Resources Department. On 08/20/2019, City Council approved the National Meter & Automation agreement to supply the City of Ocala with Badger Meters to replace the failing Elster-Amco system.

To date approximately 26,800 new meters and 17,100 endpoints have been installed. Approximately 13,600 old meters still require replacement with more than half that are manually being read.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

- Utility Metering Solutions, LLC. (UMS) was the successful competitive bidder on 03/15/2021 with the City of Greeley, Colorado to construct and install a fixed network metering system. The term of the piggyback agreement between the City of Ocala and UMS is for a one-year period.
- The cost of this project is estimated at \$732,595. The table below is a detailed breakdown of the services that will be provided by UMS.
