

FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR EMPLOYEE EVENT PLANNING AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR EMPLOYEE EVENT PLANNING AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES ("Fourth Amendment") is entered into by and between **CITY OF OCALA**, a Florida municipal corporation ("City"), and **BELLA FAIRE**, a sole proprietorship authorized to do business in the State of Florida (EIN: 27-1715474) ("Vendor").

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2019, City and Vendor entered into an Agreement for Employee Event Planning and Management Services (the "Original Agreement"), City of Ocala Contract Number: CMO/190278; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order 20-52 declaring a State of Emergency for the entire State of Florida as a result of the COVID-19 epidemic and requiring local jurisdictions to prohibit social gatherings of groups of ten (10) or more people; and

WHEREAS, this declaration, along with other local and state restrictions on social or recreational gatherings, necessitated the rescheduling of the City of Ocala's Employee Family Fun Day; and

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2020, City and Vendor entered into the First Amendment to Agreement for Employee Event Planning and Management Services (the "First Amendment") to amend the parties' respective performances under the Original Agreement considering the initial rescheduling of the City of Ocala's Employee Family Fun Day; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 epidemic continued to limit social gatherings and necessitated a second rescheduling of the City of Ocala's Employee Family Fun Day; and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2021, City and Vendor entered into the Second Amendment to Agreement for Employee Event Planning and Management Services (the "Second Amendment") to formally amend the parties' respective performances under the Original Agreement considering the second rescheduling of the City of Ocala's Employee Family Fun Day; and

WHEREAS, on February 6, 2023, City and Vendor entered into the Third Amendment to Agreement for Employee Event Planning and Management Services (the "Third Amendment") extending the term of the Original Agreement for a one-year period, from August 11, 2022 to August 10, 2023.

WHEREAS, City and Vendor now desire to extend the Original Agreement, as amended, for the final available one-year renewal period.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of each of the foregoing recitals and the following mutual covenants, conditions and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby mutually acknowledged, City and Vendor agree as follows:

- 1. **RECITALS.** City and Vendor hereby represent and warrant that the Recitals set forth above are true and correct.
- INCORPORATION OF ORIGINAL AGREEMENT. The Original Agreement between City and Vendor, as amended, is hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth herein in its entirety and remains in full force and effect, except for those terms and conditions expressly amended by this Fourth Amendment.
- 3. **RENEWAL TERM**. The Original Agreement is hereby renewed for an additional one-year term beginning **AUGUST 11, 2023** and terminating **AUGUST 10, 2024**.
- 4. **NOTICES**. All notices, certifications or communications required by this Fourth Amendment shall be given in writing and shall be deemed delivered when personally served, or when received if by facsimile transmission with a confirming copy mailed by registered or certified mail, postage

Further, a duplicate or copy of the Fourth Amendment that contains a duplicated or non-original signature will be treated the same as an original, signed copy of this original Fourth Amendment for all purposes.
- 7. **LEGAL AUTHORITY**. Each person signing this Fourth Amendment on behalf of either party individually warrants that he or she has full legal power to execute this Fourth Amendment on behalf of the party for whom he or she is signing, and to bind and obligate such party with respect to all provisions contained in this Fourth Amendment.

ELECTRONIC RECORD AND SIGNATURE DISCLOSURE

From time to time, City of Ocala - Procurement & Contracting (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Described below are the terms and conditions for providing to you such notices and disclosures electronically through the DocuSign system. Please read the information below carefully and thoroughly, and if you can access this information electronically to your satisfaction and agree to this Electronic Record and Signature Disclosure (ERSD), please confirm your agreement by selecting the check-box next to 'I agree to use electronic records and signatures' before clicking 'CONTINUE' within the DocuSign system.

Getting paper copies

At any time, you may request from us a paper copy of any record provided or made available electronically to you by us. You will have the ability to download and print documents we send to you through the DocuSign system during and immediately after the signing session and, if you elect to create a DocuSign account, you may access the documents for a limited period of time (usually 30 days) after such documents are first sent to you. After such time, if you wish for us to send you paper copies of any such documents from our office to you, you will be charged a \$0.00 per-page fee. You may request delivery of such paper copies from us by following the procedure described below.

Withdrawing your consent

If you decide to receive notices and disclosures from us electronically, you may at any time change your mind and tell us that thereafter you want to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format. How you must inform us of your decision to receive future notices and disclosure in paper format and withdraw your consent to receive notices and disclosures electronically is described below.

Consequences of changing your mind

If you elect to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format, it will slow the speed at which we can complete certain steps in transactions with you and delivering services to you because we will need first to send the required notices or disclosures to you in paper format, and then wait until we receive back from you your acknowledgment of your receipt of such paper notices or disclosures. Further, you will no longer be able to use the DocuSign system to receive required notices and consents electronically from us or to sign electronically documents from us.

All notices and disclosures will be sent to you electronically

Unless you tell us otherwise in accordance with the procedures described herein, we will provide electronically to you through the DocuSign system all required notices, disclosures, authorizations, acknowledgements, and other documents that are required to be provided or made available to you during the course of our relationship with you. To reduce the chance of you inadvertently not receiving any notice or disclosure, we prefer to provide all of the required notices and disclosures to you by the same method and to the same address that you have given us. Thus, you can receive all the disclosures and notices electronically or in paper format through the paper mail delivery system. If you do not agree with this process, please let us know as described below. Please also see the paragraph immediately above that describes the consequences of your electing not to receive delivery of the notices and disclosures electronically from us.

To request delivery from us of paper copies of the notices and disclosures previously provided by us to you electronically, you must send us an email to contracts@ocalafl.org and in the body of such request you must state your email address, full name, mailing address, and telephone number. We will bill you for any fees at that time, if any.

To withdraw your consent with City of Ocala - Procurement & Contracting

To inform us that you no longer wish to receive future notices and disclosures in electronic format you may:

i. decline to sign a document from within your signing session, and on the subsequent page, select the check-box indicating you wish to withdraw your consent, or you may;

ii. send us an email to contracts@ocalafl.org and in the body of such request you must state your email, full name, mailing address, and telephone number. We do not need any other information from you to withdraw consent.. The consequences of your withdrawing consent for online documents will be that transactions may take a longer time to process..

Required hardware and software
