The City of Ocala generates biosolids sludge at its two (2) Water Reclamation Facilities. Only Class I landfills can accept these biosolids. Under our current contract we travel 45 minutes one-way to the A.C.M.S. Heart of Florida landfill in Lake Panasoffkee in Sumter County. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) lists forty-one (41) Class I landfills in Florida. Landfills located within three hours driving distance one-way were contacted.

Additionally, our contact at A.C.M.S. informed me that we have been profiting the last five years from our original contract price of approximately \$ 35.00 per ton. They honored our Agreement while quoting higher rates to new customers these past five years. First quarter A.C.M.S. 2025 rates now start at \$ 65.00 per ton and go up to \$ 80.00 per ton for biosolids.
