STAFF RECOMMENDATION (Motion Ready):

Approve the purchase of replacement pistols for the Ocala Police Department for \$96,670

OCALA'S RELEVANT STRATEGIC GOALS:

Operational Excellence.

BACKGROUND:

The Ocala Police Department has been using the Glock .40 caliber pistols for 10 years. As the weapons have aged, more parts need to be replaced. Further, the cost of ammunition has increased for this caliber due to the lack of demand. The agency needs to purchase new sights as well because of the natural degradation of the tritium. This weapons purchase will allow us to meet operational requirements for the agency with new pistols with improved sights that operate on a more widely available caliber of ammunition (9mm). This purchase will be offset by the sales of current firearms to officers.

Prior purchases under this contract, from 11/30/21 to date, have included vehicle printer mounts, light bars, light bar tubes, gun boxes, and other vehicle accessories that were required.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

That the Ocala Police Department be allowed to make the purchase utilizing funding from the existing budget funds. The cost for the firearms will be \$96,670, which is half of the requested budgeted amount for FY 22-23. The second half of the funding is slated for FY 23-24.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funds in the amount of \$96,670 will be spent from account 001-018-831-521-52-52010 from the existing budget.

This purchase is utilizing the Bradford contract (BCSO2019-01) and under City of Ocala Munis number 211083.
