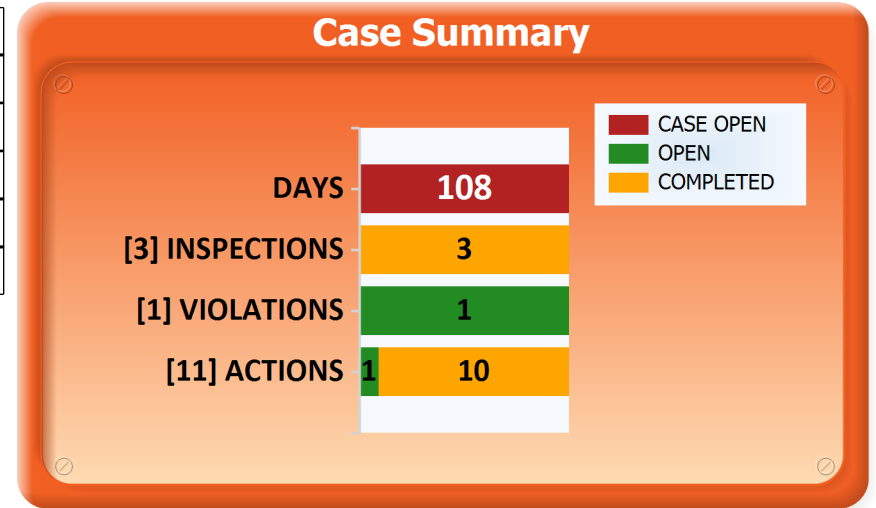

I. FINDINGS OF FACT:

- A.** The Respondent(s), **SLSM INCORPORATION INC, 6725 S FRY RD, #700-331, KATY, TX 77494-8102**, owner(s) in charge of the property described as: **200 BLK SW 13TH AVE, OCALA, FL | 2845-073-003, Ocala, Florida** recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida.
- B.** That on and between January 22nd, 2025, and March 9th, 2026, the property, as described above, was in violation of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, **SECTION 34-95 WEEDS ACCUMULATIONS OF TRASH OR OTHER UNSIGHTLY OR UNSANITARY MATTER.**

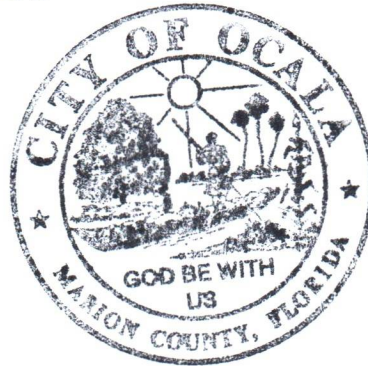

 - (c) Upon abatement of any violations of section 34-95 by the City, a \$100.00 service fee shall be applied pursuant to section 34-92(c)(2) of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances.
