



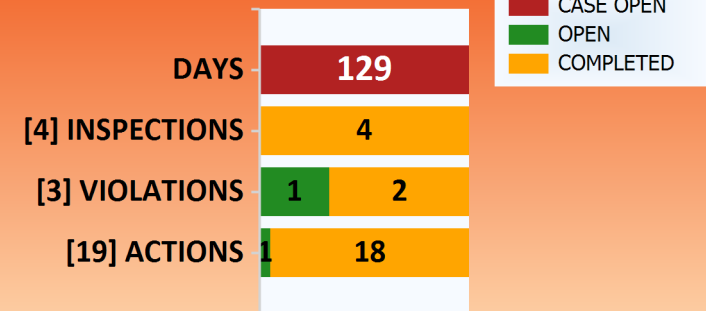

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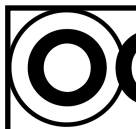

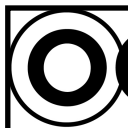

**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME
NOTICE OF HEARING ON COMPLIANCE AND IMPOSITION OF FINES**

THIS CAUSE, came for public hearing before the Municipal Code Enforcement Board on; April 9th, 2026, after due notice to the Respondent(s), and the Municipal Code Enforcement Board having heard testimony under oath, received evidence, considered stipulations, and heard argument, thereupon issues its Final Administrative Order, Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law, and Notice of Hearing on Compliance, and Imposition of Fines as follows:

I. PREVIOUS FINDINGS OF FACT: DATED FEBRUARY 17TH, 2026

- A.** The Respondent(s), **WILLIAMS, RODERICK & BRIGHAM, SETH, 1902 NW 24TH CT, OCALA, FL 34475-4825 AND REYNOLDS, RUBY, 1926 NW 12TH ST, OCALA, FL 34475**, owner(s) in charge of the property described as: **1926 NW 12TH ST, OCALA, FL | 2220-005-005, Ocala, Florida** recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida.
- B.** That on and between January 12th, 2026, and February 10th, 2026, the property, as described above, was in violation of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, **SECTION 34-95 WEEDS ACCUMULATIONS OF TRASH OR OTHER UNSIGHTLY OR UNSANITARY MATTER, SECTION 82-3 BARBED WIRE ELECTRIFIED FENCES RAZOR WIRE AND FENCES WALLS, SECTION 82-182 DANGEROUS BUILDINGS DECLARED NUISANCE; ABATEMENT REQUIRED; TIME LIMITS.**

II. PREVIOUS CONCLUSION OF LAW: DATED FEBRUARY 17TH, 2026

ADDITIONALLY, PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 162 OF THE FLORIDA STATUTES, YOU MAY HAVE OTHER ADDITIONAL RIGHTS IN REFERENCE TO ANY FINDINGS BY THE MUNICIPAL CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD.

IN THE EVENT OF NON-COMPLIANCE, AN ORDER IMPOSING A FINE SHALL BE RECORDED IN THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND THEREAFTER SHALL CONSTITUTE A LIEN AGAINST THE LAND UPON WHICH THE VIOLATION(S) EXISTS, OR UPON ANY OTHER REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY YOU.
