Mr. King,

Per our conversation, Mack Trucks will discontinue the 11 liter, MP7 engine platform January 1, 2027. This is due to the new EPA emissions regulations that take effect on the same date. Mack has chosen to use the new Cummins 10 liter engine platform. Mack estimates the new platform to add an additional \$20k to \$25k to the cost, but as of today they have made no official announcement. Additionally, the new engine platform is not listed on the current Florida Sheriffs Bid. We are working with Mack to establish actual pricing and will have it added to the FSA Bid for Oct 1, 2026. Mack has made us aware that may be chassis available with the current engine and emissions platform later this year on a first come first serve bases. This chassis will be at current Florida Sheriffs Bid pricing, a considerable discount compared to the anticipated 2027 / 2028 FSA bid.
