BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Streets Division is responsible for mowing City-maintained rights-of-way, medians, parcels, City lots, and other designated areas in the southern half of the City. The areas are mowed based on a set number of cuts per month for each month of the calendar year. This scheduled mowing ensures an acceptable appearance and contributes to the longevity of our road network. Since Public Works does not have the manpower to complete these services, a solicitation was issued for mowing services.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

On November 4, 2022, the City issued its Invitation to Bid ("ITB") No. PWD/220817 for grounds maintenance in the southern half of the City for medians, rights-of-way ("ROW"), and City lots. A total of three (3) bids were received and Extreme Enterprises of Marion County, Inc., was found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder:

Staff recommends approval of the two-year contract with Extreme Enterprises of Marion County, Inc. from January 4, 2023, through January 3, 2025, with two (2) optional one-year renewals.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for this contract is budgeted in 158-023-430-538-53-34010 for FY22-23 in the amount of \$139,404. Additional funding will be budgeted in FY23-24 in the amount of \$165,131, and in FY24-25 in the amount of \$25,728.

PROCUREMENT REVIEW:

These services were procured in compliance with the City's Procurement Policy.
