Citizen Participation Plan (CPP)

The City of Ocala is in the process of updating its Citizen Participation Plan (CPP) and is seeking public input. The Citizen Participation Plan is a document that governs how residents can participate in the development of federal funding strategies, including the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME). The CPP provides information concerning the Five-Year Comprehensive Plan, Annual Action Plan, and the Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report. Additionally, the updated plan outlines how the City of Ocala will engage with residents, particularly low to moderate-income households, to identify local housing and community development needs.
