BACKGROUND:

Ocala Electric Utility ("OEU") utilizes contractors to perform underground boring services for the installation of electrical conduit. As part of the OEU's construction program for the installation of new underground primary and secondary cables and for the replacement of failing cables, underground directional boring services are needed to install new conduit systems.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

On October 18, 2022, the City issued its Invitation to Bid ("ITB") No. ELE/220774 for boring and conduit installation services. Two (2) bids were received on November 9, 2022, with Bellmore Enterprises, Inc., as the lowest responsive bid. Bid results are shown below:

Bid pricing was solicited based on an estimated quantity of conduit in various sizes that would be used on an annual basis. The contract for underground boring and conduit installation services is for a two-year term, with two (2) optional one-year renewals.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding for boring services is included in individual projects and impacts multiple accounts in the FY23 approved budget.

PROCUREMENT REVIEW:

These goods and services were procured in compliance with the City's Procurement Policy.
