#### **PROJECT OVERVIEW**


Ocala International Airport (OCF) (CLIENT) completed a "Categorical Exclusion (CATEX) Short Form" under Federal Aviation Administration Order 1050.1f, paragraphs 5-6.1 through 5-6.6 for the proposed Property Release. In conjunction with the administrative CATEX, all Connected Actions must be included. Since the future use of the site is known, a description of the proposed land use and associated indirect impacts must be summarized and a Documented CATEX must be prepared.

#### **SCOPE OF WORK**

By request of the Client, McFarland Johnson, Inc. (CONSULTANT) will provide the following professional services and deliverables under this contract related to preparation of the Documented CATEX. The following task will be completed. Our scope of work assumes that the proposed action would involve that could affect the qualification of the project as a CATEX.

#### **TASK 1: DATA COLLECTION AND SITE RECONNAISSANCE**

The CONSULTANT will conduct a site reconnaissance walkover at the subject property identified as "Land Release Request, Dated September 9, 2022). The purpose of the reconnaissance is to document visible environmental conditions or natural features.

  Act Implementing Instructions for Airport Projects", and FAA Order 1050.1F, "Environmental Impacts
  Policies and Procedures" (February 2020).
