BACKGROUND:

The Public Works Commercial Sanitation Division is requesting approval of Contract# PWD/200400 with North Florida Container and Truck Repair for dumpster repairs. The most common dumpster repair is replacing the bottoms which extends the life of the dumpster. Generally, the bottoms can be repaired two (2) to three (3) times before the dumpster needs to be replaced.

This service provides for an effective and efficient way to repair dumpster bottoms. The Public Works Commercial Sanitation Division has the ability to perform smaller repairs in-house but is not equipped to handle large volumes in conjunction with other responsibilities.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

On September 15, 2020, Invitation to Bid # PWD/200400 was issued for dumpster repair services. Five bidders responded, and North Florida Container and Truck Repair was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
