As an entitlement community, the City of Ocala receives federal funding from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in the form of a yearly grant allocation. Pursuant to receiving this allocation, the City is required to submit an annual action plan that stipulates how the grant allocation will be disbursed and how the City will accomplish the national objectives of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program.
