### STAFF RECOMMENDATION (Motion Ready):

Approve a thirteen-month contract for fuel supply and transport load services with Petroleum Traders Corporation in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000

### BACKGROUND:

The Fleet Department manages fuel for all City vehicles and equipment. Procuring a contract for bulk fuel deliveries allows the City to purchase fuel at wholesale rates. The City of Ocala and the Marion County School Board solicited a joint bid to obtain better pricing from vendors.

### FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS:

On March 10, 2023, the Marion County School Board issued a joint solicitation, Bid# 3980GM for gasoline and diesel supply and transport services. Five (5) bids were received. Petroleum Traders Corporation was found to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The vendor was selected as the intended awardee for these services. The initial term of this contract will cover the period May 30, 2023, to June 30, 2024.
