



### FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

THIS CAUSE, came for public hearing before the Municipal Code Enforcement Special Magistrate on October 29th, 2025, after due notice to the Respondent(s), and the Municipal Code Enforcement Special Magistrate having heard testimony under oath, received evidence, considered stipulations, and heard argument, thereupon issues its Final Administrative Order, Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law, and Notice of Hearing on Compliance, and Imposition of Fines as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT:

- A. The Respondent(s), **COLESCO PARTNERS LLC**, owner(s) in charge of the property described as **30900-000-00 / 250 SW 22<sup>ND</sup> PL, Ocala, Florida** recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida.
- B. That on and between August 18th, 2025, and October 27th, 2025, the property, as described above, was in violation of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, **SECTION 34-95 WEEDS ACCUMULATIONS OF TRASH OR OTHER UNSIGHTLY OR UNSANITARY MATTER, SECTION 34-147 PERMIT FOR BOARDING-UP A VACANT COMMERCIAL STRUCTURE**.

II. CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- A. (b) Upon abatement of any violations of section 34-95 by the City, a \$100.00 service fee shall be applied pursuant to section 34-92(c)(2) of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances.

- 2.) Apply for and obtain the required permit for boarding-up a vacant commercial structure by 4:00pm on Thursday, December 25th, 2025. Once the permit is obtained the inspection for closure of the permit shall be completed within 60 days after the issuance of the initial permit. If the Respondent(s) fail to comply by 7:00am on Friday, November 21st, 2025, or if the permit issued is not inspected and finalized by the 61st day after permit issuance, there shall be a fine of \$50.00 per day thereafter that shall run in addition to any other fines until the violation has been abated.

3.) Pay the cost of prosecution of \$287.92 by November 20th, 2025.

B. This Order may be recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida, and shall constitute a lien against the above described property, and upon any other real, or personal property, owned by the Respondent(s), pursuant to Sections 162.08 and 162.09, Florida State Statutes, and Section 2-426 and 2-443, Code of Ordinances City of Ocala, Florida.
