**AMENDED FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

THIS CAUSE originally came for public hearing before the Code Enforcement Special Magistrate on August 31st, 2022 and after hearing, the Respondent was found guilty of violating City Code and Ordered to cure the violation by September 22nd, 2022, failing which a non-compliance hearing was to be held on September 28, 2022. Due to Hurricane Ian hearings scheduled for September 28, 2022 were canceled. This matter then came back before the Code Enforcement Special Magistrate and upon the request of the City, the prior Final Administrative Order is hereby Amended as set forth below to extend the date of compliance to November 21, 2022.

THIS CAUSE, initially came for public hearing before the Code Enforcement Special Magistrate on August 31st, 2022, after due notice to the Respondent(s), and the Code Enforcement Special Magistrate having heard testimony under oath, received evidence, considered stipulations, and heard argument, thereupon issues its Final Administrative Order, Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law, and Notice of Hearing on Compliance, and Imposition of Fines as follows:

**I. FINDINGS OF FACT:**

**A.** The Respondent(s), **CUMMINGS GEORGE GERALD**, owner(s) in charge of the property described as: **24563-003-00 | 2605 NE 19TH AVE, OCALA FLORIDA** recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida.

**B.** That on and between June 15, 2022 and August 31, 2022 the property, as described above, was in violation of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, Section 34-121 - Definitions, Section 34-122 - Abandoned or derelict vehicles, Section 34-91 - Definitions, Section 34-95 - Weeds; accumulations of trash or other unsightly or unsanitary matter.

**II. CONCLUSION OF LAW:**

**A.** The Respondent(s), **CUMMINGS GEORGE GERALD**, by reason of the foregoing is in violation of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, Section 34-121 - Definitions, Section 34-122 - Abandoned or derelict vehicles, Section 34-91 - Definitions, Section 34-95 - Weeds; accumulations of trash or other unsightly or unsanitary matter, in that the Respondent(s) has failed to remedy the violation(s) and is subject to the provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, Florida, Sections 2-426 and 2-443.

**III.**

**ORDER:**

**A.** Find the Respondent(s) guilty of violating city code section(s): 34-121, 34-122, 34-91, 34-95 as a Repeat Violator, per Chapter 162.04 of the Florida Statute and section(s) and Order to:

1.) (a) Remove all abandoned, untagged, or inoperable vehicles by 4:00pm on Monday, November 21st, 2022, or  
(b) Have the vehicles properly registered and operational by 4:00pm on Monday, November 21st, 2022;

If the Respondent(s) fail to comply with this section by 7:00am on Tuesday, November 22nd, 2022, there shall be a fine of \$250.00 per day thereafter that shall run addition to any other fines until this violation has been abated. Additionally, the city shall enter upon the property and take whatever steps are necessary to bring the violation(s) into compliance, to include: removal of all abandoned or derelict vehicles.



2.) (a) Cut and clean the property grounds fully and properly removing any weeds, undergrowth, junk, and debris by 4:00pm on Monday, November 21st, 2022. If the Respondent(s) fail to comply by 7:00am on Tuesday, November 22nd, 2022, the City shall enter upon the property and take whatever steps are necessary to bring the violation(s) into compliance to include: cutting and cleaning the property grounds, fully and properly removing any weeds, undergrowth, junk and debris. Additionally, there shall be a fine of \$250.00 per day thereafter that shall run addition to any other fines until this violation has been abated.

(b) Upon abatement of any violations of section 34-95 by the City, a \$100.00 service fee shall be applied pursuant to section 34-92(c)(2) of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances.

3.) Pay the cost of prosecution of \$156.40 by November 21st, 2022.

4.) There shall be an additional fine of \$500.00 assessed against the Respondent(s) as a Repeat Violator, if the Respondent(s) fails to comply with the abatement of the violations imposed in this order by November 24th, 2022.

All costs and fines will be assessed as a Lien against the property. After three (3) months from the filing of any such lien which remains unpaid, refer to the City Attorney's office for consideration of foreclosure.

B. This Order may be recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida, and shall constitute a lien against the above described property, and upon any other real, or personal property, owned by the Respondent(s), pursuant to Sections 162.08 and 162.09, Florida State Statutes, and Section 2-426 and 2-443, Code of Ordinances City of Ocala, Florida.
