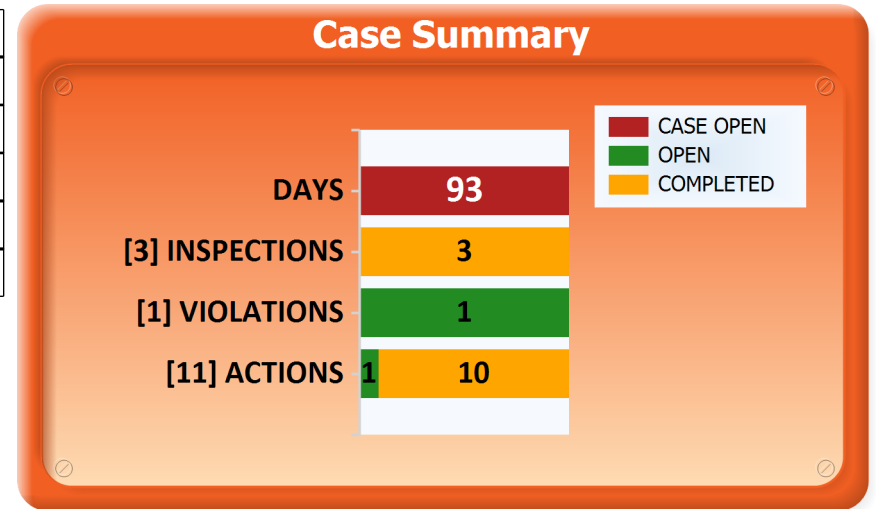

- B. That on and between January 1st, 2026, and February 10th, 2026, the property, as described above, was in violation of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, **SECTION 82-182 DANGEROUS BUILDINGS DECLARED NUISANCE; ABATEMENT REQUIRED; TIME LIMITS.**
