

FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

THIS CAUSE, came for public hearing before the Municipal Code Enforcement Board on; October 9th, 2025, after due notice to the Respondent(s), and the Municipal Code Enforcement Board having heard testimony under oath, received evidence, considered stipulations, and heard argument, thereupon issues its Final Administrative Order, Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law, and Notice of Hearing on Compliance, and Imposition of Fines as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT:

- A. The Respondent(s), AVENI, JESSICA, owner(s) in charge of the property described as 2423 NE 14TH AVE | 2448-003-000, Ocala, Florida recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida.
- B. That on and between June 12th, 2025, and October 7th, 2025, the property, as described above, was in violation of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, SECTION 34-95 WEEDS ACCUMULATIONS OF TRASH OR OTHER UNSIGHTLY OR UNSANITARY MATTER, SECTION 122-312 PERMITTED USES R-1, SECTION 122-1193 TRAILERS COMMERCIAL VEHICLE PORTABLE CONTAINERS.

II. CONCLUSION OF LAW:

A. The Respondent(s), AVENI, JESSICA, by reason of the foregoing are in violation of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, SECTION 34-95 WEEDS ACCUMULATIONS OF TRASH OR OTHER UNSIGHTLY OR UNSANITARY MATTER, SECTION 122-312 PERMITTED USES R-1, SECTION 122-1193 TRAILERS COMMERCIAL VEHICLE PORTABLE CONTAINERS, in that the Respondent(s) have failed to remedy the violation(s) and is subject to the provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, Florida, Sections 2-426 and 2-443.

III. ORDER:

- A. Find the Respondent(s) guilty of violating city code section(s): 34-95, 122-312 and 122-1193 and order to:
 - 1.) (a) Cut and clean the property grounds fully and properly removing any weeds, undergrowth, and unsightly or unsanitary items by 4:00pm on Thursday, November 6th, 2025. If the Respondent(s) fail to comply by 7:00am on Friday, November 7th, 2025, the City shall enter upon the property and take whatever steps are necessary to bring the violations into compliance, to include cutting and cleaning the property grounds, fully and properly removing any weeds, undergrowth, and unsightly or unsanitary items. Additionally, there shall be a fine of \$50.00 per day that shall run in addition to any other fines until this violation has been abated.
 - (b) Upon abatement of any violations of section 34-95 by the City, a \$100.00 service fee shall be applied pursuant to section 34-92(c)(2) of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances.

- 2,) Remove all commercial equipment and items stored (outdoors) upon property and discontinue storing items outdoors in relation to permitted uses in the R-1AA zoning district by 4:00pm on Thursday, November 6th, 2025. If the Respondent(s) fail to comply by 7:00am on Friday, November 7th, 2025, there shall be a fine of \$100 per day until this violation has been abated. Additionally, the City shall enter upon the property and take whatever steps are necessary to bring the violation(s) into compliance to include removal of all items stored outdoors upon the property.
- 3.) (a) Remove all utility trailers from the front and/or side yards and store in the rear yard or indoors only by 4:00pm on Thursday, November 6th, 2025, or
- (b) Remove all utility trailers from the property by 4:00pm on Thursday, November 6th, 2025. If the Respondent(s) fail to comply by 7:00am on Friday, November 7th, 2025, there shall be a fine of \$50 per day thereafter that shall run in addition to any other fines until all violations of section 122-1193 have been abated.
- 4.) Pay the cost of prosecution of \$313.21 by November 6th, 2025.
- B. This Order may be recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida, and shall constitute a lien against the above described property, and upon any other real, or personal property, owned by the Respondent(s), pursuant to Sections 162.08 and 162.09, Florida State Statutes, and Section 2-426 and 2-443, Code of Ordinances City of Ocala, Florida.


