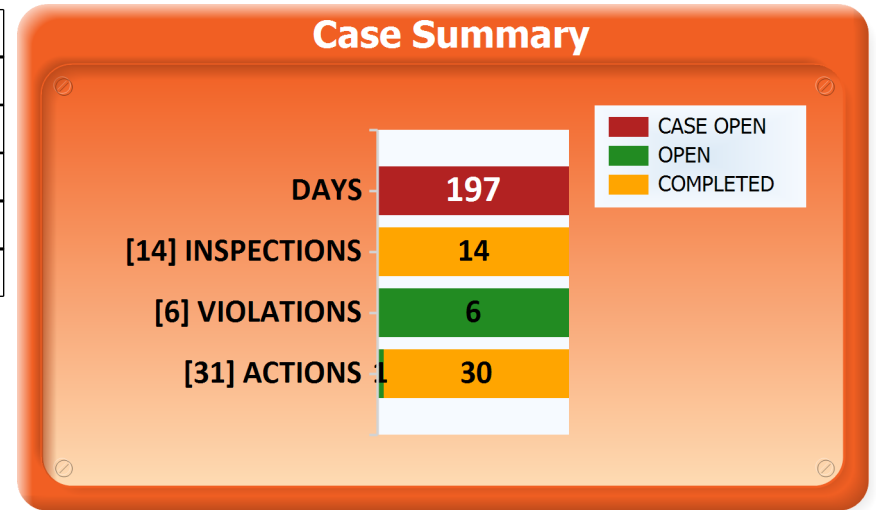

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<p>Section 82-182. - Dangerous buildings declared nuisance; abatement required; time limits.</p>	<p>DALE HOLLINGSWORTH</p>	<p>10/23/2025</p>				<p>All structures within all paintball courses (those with more than 2 vertical sides or with a roof) must be removed as all have been deemed dangerous structures by the definitions found in section 82-181 and by Florida Building Code.</p> <p>As a replacement for all structures removed and for new or alternative course barriers, Wayne's World of Paintball may use items such as vertical culverts (some already in use), short (maximum 6-feet-high) wood fence or panel style walls for barriers (some already in use), large tires stacked as vertical barriers (tires may only be outside on the course if actively used as course barriers, not simply stored and abandoned outside. Additionally, measures must be taken to ensure the tires do not collect water which may harbor insects or mosquitoes), or items primarily designed and intended for paintball courses such as inflatable barriers that are temporary in nature and able to be moved. These items listed will not require permitting for placement. As of this date (February 16, 2026) no permits have been applied for and I have not heard anything further since the February 6, 2026 text message receipt (See "Contact" chronology entry for details). February 27, 2026 is the next checkpoint for additional compliance items.</p>
						<p>2nd NOVPH Checkpoint.</p> <p>On March 2nd, 2026 I responded to Wayne's World of Paintball to conduct a follow-up inspection having reached and the February 13, 2026 and February 27, 2026 checkpoints as provided in the Notice of Violation.</p> <p>Pursuant to that Notice, first, a permitting review was conducted to determine progress with the compliance items related to the February 13, 2026 checkpoint. The only permit applied for was a demolition permit applied for on February 24, 2026 (DEMO26-0017). The scope of work outlined in this application read "Demo of 3 small accessory buildings per code request." This scope does not meet the requirements set forth in the Notice of Violation as numerous other structures are omitted in the scope.</p> <p>Additionally, no new permits have been applied for regarding required electrical and plumbing repairs. Conversation with Wayne's World of Paintball owner point of contact, Jackie, revealed there has been conversation with a plumber and electrician; however, as of this report there are no permit applications for necessary work.</p> <p>During the site inspection, we also located another outdoor shower, not previously discovered. This shower was located hidden on the side of a small shed near the main parking area, behind the large</p>

						<p>grey building which has been listed as an exception to remain. The plumbing was actively leaking, and the area surrounding the shower was wet, indicating an extended period of time of leaking and spraying to nearby grounds. A plastic pallet was used as the flooring, and a bottle of shampoo was on the wooden makeshift wall directly left of the shower knob.</p> <p>An additional checkpoint for February 27, 2026 was to complete or demonstrate significant progress towards completion of overall property clean-up of junk, debris, materials, burn piles, and trash. The site inspection on the morning of March 2, 2026 revealed minimal work has been completed towards complying with this item. I was informed a single dumpster load of debris had been removed, but the dumpster was not scheduled for return as there is an attempt to save money at the moment for other priorities with the site. During my inspection, I could tell where a couple areas were partially rid of debris, but most were still in the same condition. Even where the debris was removed, it was not cleared and remained in violation. Additionally, some areas were worse than previous inspections, and burn piles remained. To that note, a large burn pile within the main parking area had newer material added to it and smelled of recent burns. Additionally, there were three new boxes on the pile that were not wet from recent rains, indicating they were added to the pile very recently.</p> <p>Joe Thompson, a representative for Wayne's World and point of contact sent by Jackie to meet with us, walked us to one of the paintball fields. Within the field, he indicating to us they had been recently reconstructing the field, rebuilding half-walls and</p>

A quick inspection by Building Department staff and myself confirmed the items built were allowed without permits; however, this indicated to me a significant amount of time being spent on building new course structures instead of the required checkpoints towards compliance, such as basic clean-up of the property.</p> <p>Lastly, when inquired, Joe indicated the green storage building next to the welcome building was for storage. Today was the first time this building appeared to be open, with only a glass storm door closed. I asked Joe what items were stored in this facility and he advised it was used as a "Command Center" and is where radio's and such are stored. I asked if we could see the inside and he said "Sure" and led us to the building and opened the unlocked door. Inside, I immediately observed this structure was not being used for storage, and instead appeared to be lived in. A bed was on the left with what appeared to be a new package of cigarettes on the bed among other items, including two packages of cigarillos, and at least two packages (white foil package and white plastic container) used for medical marijuana. I was able to determine this observation easily based on my training and experience as a police officer in recent years. There was also clothes, personal items, food items, and a flat panel tv in front of the bed. The roofing material appeared dilapidated, and what appeared to be unsafe electrical conditions. The building department confirmed this to be an uninhabitable structure based on manufacturer intended use as a storage building in addition to the unsafe electrical conditions. I asked Joe who</p>
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						<p>was staying inside and he voluntarily entered and retrieved the white foil medical marijuana packaging and handed it to me advising, "his name is on the packing." The name read "Donald Smith Jr." and when asked, Joe confirmed that to be "Tettle," one of the workers and points-off-contact mentioned by Jackie previously.</p> <p>Finally, all vehicles, boats, trailers, and RV remain as previously found, constituting another violation of the February 27, 2026 Notice of Violation checkpoint.</p> <p>Significant work remains to be completed, and the inspection revealed both of the first to checkpoints have surpassed without any indicating of reasonable or significant progress. All of the aforementioned notes were relayed verbally to Joe on site, and to Jackie via phone. The next checkpoint is March 20, 2026 for complete or demonstrate significant progress towards removal of all abandoned/derelict vehicles, campers, and trailers, not actively placed as paintball course props. Based on the lack of permits for work, including several structures not already listed within the single demolition permit applied for, it is evident this checkpoint is nearly impossible to comply with due to the failure to comply with previous checkpoints.</p> <p>Given the time elapsed, and lack of substantial or even reasonable progress, this case will be scheduled for a Special Magistrate hearing for prosecution and implementation of required timelines for abatement.</p>
						<p>MASSEY INSPECTION On May 6, 2026, I conducted a brief inspection of</p>

COMPLIANCE	RDH	5/6/2026	5/6/2026	COMPLETED	<p>the property, primarily at the immediate welcome area, and alongside Greg McClellan who was conducting a requested plumbing permit inspection.</p> <p>Based on our review, the only work which requires permits that has been completed is the required plumbing repairs including removal of two outdoor showers and permitting the previously unpermitted water heater changeout.</p> <p>Several dilapidated storage buildings/structures in the main area were identified for removal not requiring permits and several of which have been completed. While on site for this inspection, additional removals were actively in progress.</p> <p>All structures which required to be demolished, and which require permits remain untouched, with no permits in review for their removal. At one time, a contractor was obtained to perform demolition of 3 of the structures, but that contractor has since removed themselves from the situation and the permit has been withdrawn. No new contractors have been identified to City staff regarding demolition of any structures.</p> <p>There has also been clean-up conducted in numerous areas of the property as demonstrated to me via photos provided by email from Wayne's World of Paintball. This communication remains ongoing, and I can confirm communication from all parties involved has significantly improved. Wayne's World of Paintball also has retained legal representation who has also maintained consistent contact including coordinating virtual meetings to ensure continued communication and progress.</p>
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						<p>While violations remain, it is the City's position that Wayne's World has taken adequate steps to ensure better communication and progress towards compliance and an extension may be warranted to provide additional time to continue their pursuit of compliance without immediate imposition of fines. While this decision is ultimately the decision to be made by the Code Enforcement Board, staff is prepared to support that extension at this time.</p>

FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

THIS CAUSE, came for public hearing before the Municipal Code Enforcement Special Magistrate on March 25th, 2026, after due notice to the Respondent(s), and the Municipal Code Enforcement Special Magistrate having heard testimony under oath, received evidence, considered stipulations, and heard argument, thereupon issues its Final Administrative Order, Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law, and Notice of Hearing on Compliance, and Imposition of Fines as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT:

- A.** The Respondent(s), **PRIEST FAMILY TRUST, PRIEST, HENRY CAMP TR, AND WAYNE'S WORLD OF PAINTBALL**, owner(s) in charge of the property described as **31299-000-00 / 4841 S. PINE AVE, Ocala, Florida** recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida.
- B.** That on and between October 23rd, 2025, and March 20th, 2026, the property, as described above, was in violation of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, **SECTION 54-5 BURIAL OR BURNING OF MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE OR RECOVERED MATERIALS, SECTION 34-122 ABANDONED OR DERELICT VEHICLES, SECTION 34-95 WEEDS ACCUMULATIONS OF TRASH OR OTHER UNSIGHTLY OR UNSANITARY MATTER, SECTION 82-182 DANGEROUS BUILDINGA DECLARED NUISANCE; ABATEMENT REQUIRED; TIME LIMITS, SECTION 122-51 BUILDING PERMIT REQUIRED.**

II. CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- A.** The Respondent(s), **PRIEST FAMILY TRUST, PRIEST, HENRY CAMP TR, AND WAYNE'S WORLD OF PAINTBALL**, by reason of the foregoing are in violation of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, **SECTION 54-5 BURIAL OR BURNING OF MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE OR RECOVERED MATERIALS, SECTION 34-122 ABANDONED OR DERELICT VEHICLES, SECTION 34-95 WEEDS ACCUMULATIONS OF TRASH OR OTHER UNSIGHTLY OR UNSANITARY MATTER, SECTION 82-182 DANGEROUS BUILDINGA DECLARED NUISANCE; ABATEMENT REQUIRED; TIME LIMITS, SECTION 122-51 BUILDING PERMIT REQUIRED**, in that the Respondent(s) have failed to remedy the violation(s) and is subject to the provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, Florida, Sections 2-426 and 2-443.

III. ORDER:

- A.** Find the Respondent(s) guilty of violating city code section(s): 34-95, 34-122, 54-5, 82-181, 82-182, and 122-51 and order to:
 - 1.) Remove all junk, trash, debris, and other unsightly materials from the property by 4:00pm on Thursday, April 30th, 2026. Such materials shall include, but are not limited to, old or unusable materials, discarded items, tires not actively being used as props in active paintball courses, and the old or unused camping tent currently located within one of the staging areas.

If the Respondent(s) fail to comply by 7:00am on Friday, May 1st, 2026, there shall be a fine of \$50.00 per day thereafter that shall run in addition to any other fines until this violation has been abated.

2.) Remove all abandoned, derelict, or inoperable vehicles from the property by 4:00pm on Thursday, April 30th, 2026. Vehicles that are actively being utilized as props within an active paintball course may remain on the property; however, such vehicles must be cleared of any accumulated junk, debris, and any perceived safety hazards.

This requirement shall also apply to any boats, airplane fuselage, campers, recreational vehicles (RV's), utility trailers, and cargo trailers that are not actively being utilized as props within an active paintball course. Any such items not actively used as part of an active paintball course must be removed from the property.

If the Respondent(s) fail to comply by 7:00am on Friday, May 1st, 2026, there shall be a fine of \$50.00 per day thereafter that shall run in addition to any other fines until this violation has been abated.

3.) Remove all burn piles located on the property by 4:00pm on Thursday, April 30th, 2026. All burned trash, debris, and other materials associated with such burn piles shall be properly removed and disposed of. Additionally, the Respondent(s) shall immediately discontinue the burning of municipal solid waste on the property.

If the Respondent(s) fail to comply by 7:00am on Friday, May 1st, 2026, there shall be a fine of \$50.00 per day thereafter that shall run in addition to any other fines until this violation has been abated.

4.) Address all unsafe or dangerous structures located on the property as follows:

a.) All structures located within paintball courses that contain more than two vertical sides or any form of roof covering shall be removed from the property by 4:00pm on Thursday, April 30th, 2026, unless such structures are brought into compliance with the Current Florida Building Code through properly issued permits and inspections.

b.) If the Respondent(s) fail to obtain the required demolition permit(s) by 7:00am on Friday, May 1st, 2026, or if the permit(s) issued are not inspected and finalized by the 91st day after permit issuance, there shall be a fine of \$50.00 per day thereafter that shall run in addition to any other fines until the violations have been abated.

Thank you for the update and for providing the additional information.

For clarification, the request to board up the structures was communicated as a temporary safety measure for participants during the previously discussed overnight event, as well as any activities occurring at Wayne's World prior to achieving full compliance. However, this was not, and has never been, a method of achieving compliance with applicable codes.

Neither the original notices of violation, nor the subsequent notices, nor the Special Magistrate's Order include boarding of structures as an approved corrective action. As outlined in those documents, the only paths to compliance for the structures in question are:

Demolition of the structures; or
Obtaining the appropriate permits and completing repairs to bring the structures into compliance with the current Florida Building Code.

At this time, those required corrective actions have not been completed. As such, the structures remain in violation regardless of any boarding that may have occurred.

For your reference, I have attached the original notice issued in January, the follow-up notice issued in March, and the Special Magistrate's Order from the March hearing, all of which outline the required compliance actions.

On Wednesday, April 1, Joe met with Paul from Grant Electric regarding electrical issues.

Also, I understand that we were instructed to remove our wash station.

Ciraco Electric removed the electrical source at the wash station. As this is the only source of water for the players on the field, I am requesting that you waive the requirement to remove the wash station.

The pump was installed by and is maintained by Smokey's Pump, who also installed the Chlorinator. The water is checked quarterly by A T Environmental, who sends the water samples to Aqua Pure for testing, and who then forwards the test results to the Marion County Health Dept.

Without our wash station, players will be forced to drink water from a hose, which is unsanitary and unhealthy.
