4. Grants / Applications

Economic Development Specialist Marie Mesidieu displayed various photos and a brief overview of the finished project for the property at 130 NW 17th Street.

5. Project Updates

Economic Development Manager Roberto Ellis provided a brief update on the Imagine North Magnolia conceptual plan. Three underground storage tanks will be removed in parcel labeled G. In Project Area 2, the City is seeking applicants that can do mixed use, residential and commercial development. Procurement is looking for applicants that are financially capable of completing the project. The design has to be approved by the City. The applicants should have experience with property development. There will be an Invitation to Negotiate issued for single family lots.

Mr. Ellis said the property owner on 730 North Magnolia Avenue approached the City about acquiring a portion of the parcel that is owned by the City.

Mr. Yandle asked if the property was affected by the flood zone. Mr. Ellis replied the property is in a flood zone and will require special accommodations through the Engineering Department.

6. Other Business

Mr. Ellis said the new spring banners were delivered. The bracket replacements for the poles were installed and all the banners will be stored in a single location.

Code Enforcement Supervisor Jennipher Buller provided photos and a brief update on recent code enforcement cases. The property at 238 NW 8th Place is scheduled for a code enforcement hearing on March 18th if the property is not brought into compliance.

Mr. Yandle said there is a house on 8th Place with scattered car parts and derelict vehicles. Ms. Buller replied she would follow up on the property.

Ms. Buller said the City cleaned the property at 122 NW 17th Place and now there is a lien on the property. Staff is working with the property owner at 837 NW 4th Avenue for derelict vehicles and unsightly matter. The property at 1807 North Magnolia Avenue is not in compliance and the daily fines are at \$200 dollars per day. The property at 819 NW 4th Avenue was brought into compliance by the owner. The property owner at 1711 NW 3rd Avenue asked staff for assistance to get the property into compliance.

Mr. Yandle said the North Magnolia CRA balance is longer then what is being expended and the City needs more staff to get the work completed. Mr. Ellis replied there has been internal restructuring the Economic Development Division has a good team now to get the projects done.

Mr. Yandle asked if the City was trying to buy some of the dilapidated buildings. Mr. Ellis responded there are some properties that the City would like to acquire.
