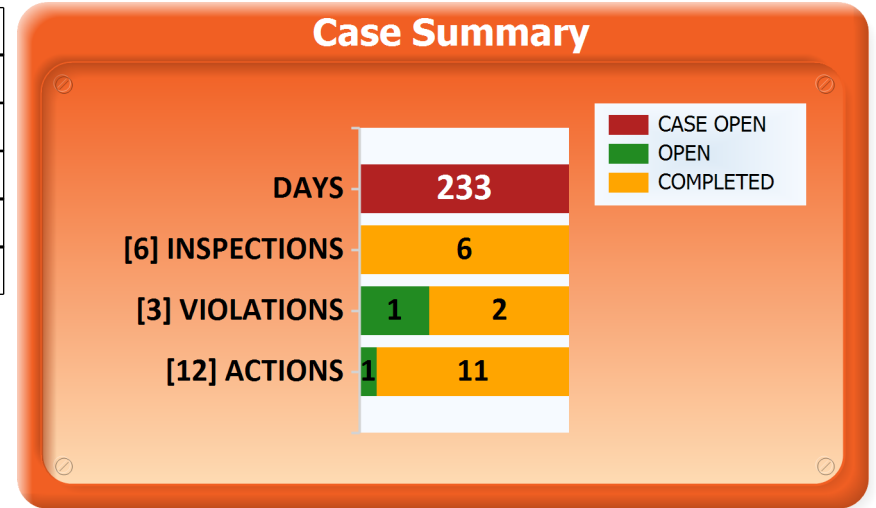

I. FINDINGS OF FACT:

- B. That on and between September 30th, 2025, and April 6th, 2026, the property, as described above, was in violation of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, **SECTION 122-51 BUILDING PERMIT REQUIRED**.

II. CONCLUSION OF LAW:

- A.
