

FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

THIS CAUSE, came for public hearing before the Code Enforcement Special Magistrate on March 29, 2023, after due notice to the Respondent(s), and the Code Enforcement Special Magistrate having heard testimony under oath, received evidence, considered stipulations, and heard argument, thereupon issues its Final Administrative Order, Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law, and Notice of Hearing on Compliance, and Imposition of Fines as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT:

- A. The Respondent(s), DELIFORD EVA THOMPSON EST OF, AND C/O BETTY F TANNER, owner(s) in charge of the property described as: 2260-148-018 | 200 BLK OF NW 1ST ST, OCALA FLORIDA recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida.
- **B.** That on and between December 19, 2022 and March 29, 2023 the property, as described above, was in violation of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, Section 34-91 Definitions, Section 34-95 Weeds; accumulations of trash or other unsightly or unsanitary matter, Section 34-121 Definitions, Section 34-122 Abandoned or derelict vehicles, Section 122-332 Permitted Uses (R-2).

II. CONCLUSION OF LAW:

A. The Respondent(s), **DELIFORD EVA THOMPSON EST OF, AND C/O BETTY F TANNER**, by reason of the foregoing are in violation of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, Section 34-91 - Definitions, Section 34-95 - Weeds; accumulations of trash or other unsightly or unsanitary matter, Section 34-121 - Definitions, Section 34-122 - Abandoned or derelict vehicles, Section 122-332 - Permitted Uses (R-2), in that the Respondent(s) have failed to remedy the violation(s) and are subject to the provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, Florida, Sections 2-426 and 2-443.

III. ORDER:

- A. Find the Respondent(s) guilty of violating city code section(s): 34-91, 34-95, 34-121, 34-122, 122-332 and Order to;
- 1.) (a) Cut and clean the property grounds fully and properly removing any weeds, undergrowth, junk, and debris by 4:00pm on Thursday, April 20th, 2023. If the Respondent(s) fail to comply by 7:00am on Friday, April 21st, 2023, the City shall enter upon the property and take whatever steps are necessary to bring the violation(s) into compliance to include: cutting and cleaning the property grounds, fully and properly removing any weeds, undergrowth, junk and debris. Additionally, there shall be a fine of \$50.00 per day thereafter that shall run addition to any other fines until this violation has been abated.
- (b) Upon abatement of any violations of section 34-95 by the City, a \$100.00 service fee shall be applied pursuant to section 34-92(c)(2) of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances.

- 2.) (a) Remove all abandoned, untagged, or inoperable vehicles by 4:00pm on Thursday, April 20th, 2023; or (b) Have the vehicles properly registered and operational by 4:00pm on Thursday, April 20th, 2023; If the Respondent(s) fail to comply with this section by 7:00am on Friday, April 21st, 2023, there shall be a fine of \$50.00 per day thereafter that shall run addition to any other fines until this violation has been abated. Additionally, the city shall enter upon the property and take whatever steps are necessary to bring the violation(s) into compliance, to include: removal of all abandoned or derelict vehicles.
- 3.)Comply with requirements for R-2 zoning to include; but not limited Residential uses, Community residential home, maximum of eight unrelated residents per single-family residential dwelling by 4:00pm on Thursday, April 20th, 2023. If the Respondent(s) fail to comply by 7:00 am on Friday, April 21st, 2023, the City shall enter upon the property and take whatever steps are necessary to bring the violations into compliance, to include: removal of improper outdoor storage to include, but not limited to vehicles, commercial vehicles, and trailers stored outdoors. Additionally, there shall be a fine of \$250 per day thereafter that shall run in addition to any other fines.
- 4.) Pay the cost of prosecution of \$166.95 by April 20th, 2023.

All costs and fines will be assessed as a Lien against the property. After three (3) months from the filing of any such lien which remains unpaid, refer to the City Attorney's office for consideration of foreclosure.

- **B.** This Order may be recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida, and shall constitute a lien against the above described property, and upon any other real, or personal property, owned by the Respondent(s), pursuant to Sections 162.08 and 162.09, Florida State Statutes, and Section 2-426 and 2-443, Code of Ordinances City of Ocala, Florida.
- **C.** The holder of this Order, and the lien arising hereunder, is the City of Ocala, a Florida Municipal Corporation, with the address of: 110 S.E. Watula Avenue, Ocala, Florida 34471.


