



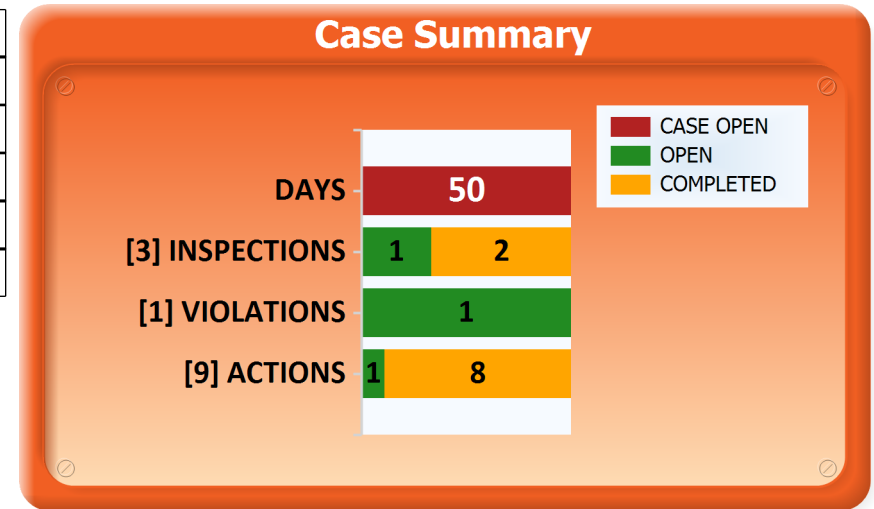



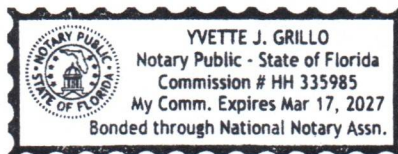

FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

THIS CAUSE, came for public hearing before the Code Enforcement Special Magistrate on May 29, 2024, after due notice to the Respondent(s), and the Code Enforcement Special Magistrate having heard testimony under oath, received evidence, considered stipulations, and heard argument, thereupon issues its Final Administrative Order, Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law, and Notice of Hearing on Compliance, and Imposition of Fines as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT:

A. The Respondent(s), **STEWART, MICHAEL ANDERSON EST**, owner(s) in charge of the property described as: **2614-003-006 | 1224 NE 10TH AVE OCALA, OCALA, FLORIDA** recorded in the Public Records of Marion County, Florida.

B. That on and between April 22, 2024 and May 29, 2024 the property, as described above, was in violation of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances, Section 34-95 - Weeds; accumulations of trash or other unsightly or unsanitary matter.

11. CONCLUSION OF LAW:

A. The Respondent(s), **STEWART, MICHAEL ANDERSON EST**, by reason of the foregoing is in violation of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, Section 34-95 - Weeds; accumulations of trash or other unsightly or unsanitary matter, in that the Respondent(s) has failed to remedy the violation(s) and is subject to the provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ocala, Florida, Sections 2-426 and 2-443.

III. ORDER:

(b) Upon abatement of any violations of section 34-95 by the City, a \$100.00 service fee shall be applied pursuant to section 34-92(c)(2) of the City of Ocala Code of Ordinances.

2.) Pay the cost of prosecution of \$182.18 by June 20th, 2024.


